

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-032

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA, COUNTY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH PETERSON CAT FOR A COMPACT SKID STEER TRACTOR FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$70,000

WHEREAS, the City Council has adopted a goal of improving street maintenance efforts, including repair of potholes; and

WHEREAS, several City streets have two to four-inch overlays which are experiencing longitudinal pothole failure; and

WHEREAS, the most effective way to provide long term repair for these types of failures is to "dig-out" the failed area and then place hot mix asphalt compacted in place with a compaction roller; and

WHEREAS, the City recently joined the National Joint Powers Alliance, a nationwide public agency purchasing agent that solicits bids from various vendors for materials, equipment and supplies; and

WHEREAS, the City has received a quote for the purchase of the skid steer tractor with planer attachments from Peterson Cat in the amount of \$69,967.33; and

WHEREAS, staff has confirmed that the quote from Peterson Cat is competitive compared to other vendors for similar equipment; and

WHEREAS, there is \$70,005 in available appropriations under Account Numbers 15-4970-4821; \$23,335, 02-4131-4821; \$23,335 and 03-4141-482; \$23,335 in the FY 2017-18 Budget for the purchase of the skid steer tractor.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Calistoga authorizes the City Manager to execute a Purchase Agreement with Peterson Cat in an amount not to exceed \$70,000 and authorizes staff to procure the equipment.
