**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A RECIPROCAL SERVICES
AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF ST. HELENA FOR RECIPROCAL BUILDING
INSPECTION SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Cities of St. Helena and Calistoga each recognize the value and benefits to both parties in sharing personnel for certain public service functions provided by the parties; and

WHEREAS, each city employs a building official to perform building inspection services on their behalf; and

WHEREAS, on a limited basis, St. Helena and Calistoga desire to cooperate in providing critical building inspection services when an official for one party is unavailable for a short period of time due to illness, personal leave, or other short-term absence, and reduce or eliminate the need to retain contract building inspection services during a building official's unavailability; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into an agreement to define the type and scope of the limited reciprocal use of their respective building official on an as-needed basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into the Reciprocal Services Agreement with the City of St. Helena attached hereto as Exhibit A.


