

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-116

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA, COUNTY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING AN ENRICHMENT GRANT OF \$50,000 TO THE CALISTOGA FIREFIGHTER'S ASSOCIATION TO BENEFIT COMMUNITY MEMBERS WHO SUFFERED LOSS FROM THE TUBBS FIRE

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2017, the Tubbs Fire ignited in the Bennett Lane area of Highway 128, outside the city limits of Calistoga; and

WHEREAS, the Tubbs Fire became one of the worst disasters in California history; and

WHEREAS, the Calistoga Firefighter's Association is holding a fundraiser to help those injured in the fire; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED the Calistoga City Council authorizes an enrichment grant in the amount of \$50,000 to the Calistoga Firefighter's Association to benefit community members who suffered loss from the Tubbs Fire.

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED the grant will be funded from donation will be funded from unassigned general fund balance reserves in General Fund account 01-4107.
