

**RESOLUTION NO. 2016-083**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA, COUNTY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING THE NAPA COUNTYWIDE PEDESTRIAN PLAN**

---

**WHEREAS**, Napa Valley Transportation Authority (NVTA) cooperatively developed a Napa Countywide Pedestrian Plan (the Plan) that will guide development and enhancement of pedestrian facilities and programs within the cities and unincorporated areas of Napa County;

**WHEREAS**, the Napa Countywide Pedestrian Plan is consistent with the Calistoga General Plan and Active Transportation Plan since the Countywide Pedestrian Plan builds upon the policies and objectives of the these plans and addresses pedestrian safety in Calistoga's downtown; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 20, 2016, the Board of the NVTA certified the Plan's Mitigated Negative Declaration and adopted a mitigation monitoring and reporting program in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act; and

**WHEREAS**, after considering the Plan during a meeting on October 3, 2016 and receiving written and oral reports by staff and public testimony, the Calistoga Active Transportation Advisory Committee unanimously recommended that the City Council adopt the Plan;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council considered the Plan at its regular meeting on October 18, 2016 and prior to taking action, the Council received written and oral reports by staff, and received public testimony.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Calistoga, based on the above findings, adopts the Napa Countywide Pedestrian Plan dated August 2016.
