**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA,
COUNTY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, PROCLAIMING CONTINUED
EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY CAUSED BY FAILURE OF THE
DUNAWEAR WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT WET PIT EFFLUENT PUMPS**

WHEREAS, a period of local emergency presently exists in the City of Calistoga in accordance with the declaration thereof by the City Council on September 2, 2014 as a result of the existing conditions of extreme peril at the Dunawear Wastewater Treatment Plant and without immediate corrective action the threat of serious harm to life, health and property will continue; and

WHEREAS, Section 22050 of the Public Contracts Code requires that the City Council of the City of Calistoga make a determination, at each subsequent City Council meeting until the emergency condition is terminated, the need for continuing emergency action; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Calistoga has reviewed the need to continue the previously approved emergency action and direction to staff; and

WHEREAS, the situation resulting from said conditions of extreme peril is still deemed to be beyond the control of normal protective services, personnel, equipment and facilities of and within said City of Calistoga.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Calistoga, State of California, hereby proclaims the extension of the period of local emergency through January 20, 2015 unless sooner terminated.
